New Voices is a community-based advocacy magazine of the **Mennonite New Life Centre of Toronto** that features articles written by internationally trained journalists living in Toronto. The first two issues of this publication focused on Poverty, Employment and Social Change.

The third issue of *New Voices* will be devoted to the theme of **Civic Participation and Newcomer Voices**. **How are newcomers making their voices heard? How are they participating as voters and candidates in elections? How are they organizing their communities to push for social change?** We will select **5 submissions** that represent diverse perspectives on issues related to civic engagement, community organizing and the political participation of newcomer communities in Canada. We welcome submissions that use different styles and genres, including news articles, opinion pieces, photojournalism and poetry. All submissions must be between **700-800 words**.

As a mentoring opportunity, the selected journalists/writers will meet as a team and work one-on-one with a professional editor prior to publication of revised and edited articles. They will receive a small honorarium for their efforts. All articles will be published alongside a short biography and a photograph of the author.
