### **Fare Inspectors**

Fare Inspectors work in partnership with other TTC employees to protect TTC's revenue base by delivering a customer-focused revenue protection service and promote increased revenue through more taps, correct fares and reliable equipment. Fare Inspectors are designated as Provincial Offences Officers to enforce TTC By-law No. 1.

The Fare Inspector role is a permanent full-time position.

- Customer Service experience in hospitality, health care or social services
- Working knowledge of security or law enforcement
