BRIDGE TO EMPLOYMENT IN SERVICES FOR IMMIGRANT POPULATIONS (BESIP)

BESIP provides internationally educated professionals (IEPs) with entry to high-demand jobs such as Settlement Counsellor, Employment Counsellor, Service Navigator, Program Coordinator.

BRIDGE FOR IMMIGRANT WOMEN RESKILLING INTO IT CODING PROFESSIONS (C-WOMEN)

The C-Women Program aims to support immigrants who identify as women or non-binary with different professional backgrounds in accessing and succeeding in high-demand and high-paying careers in IT regardless of their previous education or experience.
