BRIDGE TO EMPLOYMENT IN SERVICES FOR IMMIGRANT POPULATIONS (BESIP)

BESIP provides internationally educated professionals (IEPs) with entry to high-demand jobs such as Settlement Counsellor, Employment Counsellor, Service Navigator, Program Coordinator.

BRIDGE FOR IMMIGRANT WOMEN RESKILLING INTO IT CODING PROFESSIONS (C-WOMEN)

The C-Women Program supports immigrant women from all professional backgrounds in obtaining working knowledge of coding and testing to enter the IT sector.
